# **Education Requirement**

Foreign monks, nuns and laymen who apply for one year Diploma course must have passed at least the Matriculation or equivalent. For the laymen of Myanmar citizen must have their first degree, B.A. or B.Sc. Myanmar monks and nuns who apply for Diploma course must not be younger than 18 and not older than 45 Age limit for students. A who apply for the one-year Diploma course only will be given special consideration.

The Selection Board reserves the right to decide whether a particular applicant has met the requirements or not.

# **Entrance Examination**

Foreign candidates are required to sit for the written examination at the Embassy of Myanmar in the country of their residence, or at the examination centre in Yangon, Myanmar. There will be two question papers, namely, one on English proficiency and the other on general knowledge relevant to Buddhism. The closing date for submitting application form for Diploma course is 15<sup>th</sup> December 2010. The candidates must sit for personal interview at the Embassy of Myanmar in the country of their residence before joining the University. The admission policy of the University is liberal and flexible enough to get the qualified students for Diploma course. Priority will be given to foreign students. The students who join the University are required to bring a proper medical certificate recently taken from any recognized medical authority showing physical and mental fitness.

# Visa & Other expenses

Once a foreign student is admitted to the Diploma course, the Ministry of Religious Affairs will take care of visa application and its extension. Tuition, boarding and messing for foreign students will be provided free by the University. Travelling expenses for joining the University will not be borne by the University.

#### Accomodation


The University provides foreign students with free accomodation and meals.



# The International Theravāda Buddhist Missionary University, Yangon, Myanmar



The International Theravāda Buddhist Missionary University was inaugurated on 9<sup>th</sup> December 1998. It is located on the beautiful site of the sacred Dhammapāla Hill near the Sacred Tooth Relic Pagoda, Yangon, Myanmar.

Myanmar has carefully preserved Theravāda Buddhism in its pristine form for nearly one thousand years. Now she is sharing her knowledge of Buddhism both in theory and practice with the people of the world to promote their happiness and moral well-being. Those who wish to learn Theravāda Buddhist canonical texts and insight meditation in Myanmar tradition have a golden opportunity to study them from the Myanmar Buddhist scholars of high academic achievements at the same institution. The Myanmar and Pāli languages are included in the academic programmes. The medium of instruction is English.

## **Objectives**

There are five objectives of the university:

- (a) to share the genuine Theravada Buddhism (the teachings of Gotama Buddha) with the people of the world.
- (b) to study and comprehend the canonical texts of Theravāda Pitaka as approved successively by the six Buddhist Councils.
- (c) to obstain from evil deeds and practice good deeds.
- (d) to promote the four modes of sublime living (Brahma-vihāra) which would lead to the establishment of peaceful and prosperous world.
- (e) to train more missionaries endowed with good morality who are well-versed in Pitika literature and meditational practices.

#### **Functions of the Academic Staff**

The academic staff of the International Theravada Buddhist Missionary University have to perform both teaching and research. Teaching includes conducting tutorial, seminars, workshops, symposia and excursions to historical sites. Research work will be carried out by the academic staff individually as well as by the Department of Research.

## **Diploma and Degrees**

One year diploma and three kinds of degree are offered for under-graduate and post-graduate students. They are as follows;

- (1) One-year diploma course Diploma in Buddha Dhamma, Dip, (B.Dh).
- (2) Two-year ordinary degree course Bachelor of Arts in Buddha Dhamma, B.A. (B.Dh).
- (3) Three-year M.A. course
  Master of Arts in Buddha Dhamma,
  M.A. (B.Dh).
- (4) Four-year Ph.D course Doctor of Philosophy in Buddha Dhamma, Ph.D. (B.Dh).

One year, Diploma course in Buddha Dhamma was introduced in December 1998. Two-year Degree course was started in the following year.

Until now, Diploma conferring ceremonies were held for three times and the First Convocation for B.A. (Buddha Dhamma) degree was held in June 2002. Diploma certificates have already been presented to 192 foreign and local students. B.A (B.Dh) degree was conferred to 14 foreign students from different countries and 29 Myanmar students.

M.A. (B.Dh) course has already been started in June 2002-2003 academic year.

Right now the International Theravada Buddhist Missionary University has 91 foreign students representing 17 countries and 90 Myanmar students attending different courses.

## Academic Requirements

Anyone regardless of gender, race, religion and creed, having educational qualifications prescribed by the University, can apply for admission to the University. However, students are required to sit for the entrance examination.

Any applicant for Diploma in Buddha Dhamma will have to meet the following requirements;

- 1. The foreign monks, nuns and laymen must have passed at least the Matriculation or equivalent. For the laymen and nuns who are Myanmar citizens must have their first degrees B.A. or B.Sc. Myanmar monks must have passed Dhammācariya examination.
- 2. The candidates need to sit for an entrance examination prescribed by the University.
- 3. They should have some knowledge of Pāli, Sanskrit, Theravāda Buddhist Scriptures, fluency in spoken and written English is desirable.
